Submit application by deadline

Verification must be provided as requested

The award is earned by the club with the highest number of total audited points

Club must be in good standing with District and National Exchange Club

**AWARD:** Certificate awarded to the individual who best exemplifies the

principles and ideals of Exchange.

**ELIGIBILITY:** Any active member, in good standing, of a Four Corners'

District Exchange Club as of month end prior to convention

**JUDGING:** Four Corners' District Awards Committee

**CRITERIA:** 1) Nominations must be made by a club **Officer** or **their Division Director** 

2) The nomination sheet must be submitted by the deadline

3) The committee will judge the entries based entirely on the information contained in the narrative and application

4) The narrative should focus on specific activities during the administrative year, but may include information on past year's activities

\* A narrative, not to exceed one page. Narrative more than one page in length will be returned to the writer and will not be considered until returned within the one-page limit. Some suggestions for the narrative: is the person a volunteer; do they say yes when asked; does their presence enhance meetings, social functions and other events; are they positive, enthusiastic, loyal, creative, gregarious, possess a sense of humor and solve problems. There are 50 points maximum for the narrative. (See Appendix A for narrative of a previous National winner).

#### **MEMBERSHIP AWARD**

**AWARD:** A Four Corners' District Membership certificate will be presented at the

District Convention to all Clubs that have net growth from July 1 by end

of previous month of convention

**ELIGIBILITY:** All Four Corners' District Clubs in good standing

**JUDGING:** Membership records as maintained by National

**CRITERIA:** Net growth will be calculated by dividing the number of members

as of July 1, by the number of members on the current membership roster by end of previous month of convention, so the award can be presented at

District Convention.

#### **CLUB BUILDER AWARD**

**AWARD:** A Four Corners' District Club Builder Award certificate will be presented at the

District Convention to the club and individuals which have successfully organized or reorganized another club. This award recognizes those clubs that have worked to extend Exchange's service outreach into new communities

through the chartering of a new club.

**ELIGIBILITY:** All Four Corners' District Clubs in good standing

**JUDGING:** Four Corners' District Awards Committee

**CRITERIA:** The organized or reorganized club must have held its Permanent

Organization Meeting after April 30 of the previous year

#### **CLUB PUBLICATION OF THE YEAR AWARD**

**AWARD:** Best Club Publication and/or Newsletter award will be presented to the

club that publishes the best publication/Newsletter.

**ELIGIBILITY:** The official publication of all Four Corners' District clubs in

good standing

**JUDGING:** Four Corners' District Awards Committee

**CRITERIA:** 1. A sample copy of the publication must be submitted for

judging by the awards committee

2. Judging criteria will include display of the Exchange Club

emblem, masthead and club data, content, balance, Exchange education and promotion, readability, layout

and regularity

**DEFINITIONS:** Publication – shall be considered Facebook posts, or other social

media posts, or brochure

Newsletters – weekly or monthly electronic updates sent to club members on

a regular basis (could include club board minutes) which is required for BIG

## CLUB ATTENDANCE AWARD AT THE DISTRICT CONVENTION

**AWARD:** Club Attendance Award will be presented at the District Convention to the

club with the largest number of club members in attendance at the convention

"CALL TO ORDER"

ELIGIBILITY: Four Corners' District Clubs in good standing

JUDGING: Official roll call records of the District Secretary

**CRITERIA:** 1) Members must be in good standing

2) The count is not restricted to registered delegates, but will include

all members present

#### TRAVEL AWARD TO THE DISTRICT CONVENTION

**AWARD:** A travel award will be presented at the District Convention to the club in

attendance at the Convention "CALL TO ORDER" that traveled the

farthest number of miles to the convention site.

**ELIGIBILITY:** Four Corners' District Clubs in good standing

**JUDGING:** Official roll call records of the District Secretary

**CRITERIA:** 1) Members must be in good standing.

2) The count will not be restricted to voting delegates but will

include all members present.

3) The number of land miles traveled to the convention site will

be determined by standard atlas distance.

#### LIFETIME ACHIEVEMENT AWARD

**AWARD:** A plaque will be awarded to each honoree. The award will be given at the Four

Corners' District Convention Installation Banquet.

**PURPOSE:** The Lifetime Achievement Award was created to recognize Exchange Club members

who have devoted a lifetime to our Exchange organization, at the Club, District, National levels and our national project of Child Abuse Prevention. These individuals truly exemplify our Exchange Covenant of Service. This award recognizes members for their service, leadership, dedication, loyalty, time and achievements throughout

their membership in Exchange.

**ELIGIBILITY:** Be nominated by their club, District President, Division Director or Volunteer Field

Representative (VFR). Must be an active member in good standing of a Four Corners'

District Exchange Club. Must have at least ten years membership in Exchange.

Posthumous nominees are exempt from active membership requirement. Nominee can

only be submitted once.

ACHIEVEMENTS: Complete the nomination form, giving ample recognition for leadership, service,

dedication, growth, attendance/participation, child abuse prevention participation and several programs/projects/contributions. There is also space for a written narrative and suggestions. Consideration is given to all levels of service. Nominees will be given a

score of one to ten, with ten being the best.

**JUDGING:** Judging will be done by the awards committee.

**RECIPIENTS:** The Lifetime Achievement Award will be limited to three recipients per year

Club members are recognized but not limited to four basic areas. Input to the nominations should come from any source that will give a true picture of the nominee's qualifications to include the nominee himself/herself.

- 1. DEDICATION: Includes attendance at meetings, social events, support of Club Officers and willingness to serve.
- 2. SERVICE TO COMMUNITY: Includes participation in club's programs of service, fundraisers and our National Program, the Prevention of Child Abuse
- 3. LOYALTY TO AND SUPPORT OF IDEAS OF EXCHANGE: At the Club, District, and National level, includes support of District and National, attendance at convention and new member sponsorship
- 4. RECOGNITION AND ACHIEVEMENT: Includes special awards, special recognition, creativity, especially in the area of ideas which have noteworthy items that makes this nominee stand out

#### **NARRATIVE**

Use this space to highlight strengths especially in the area of building and supporting Exchange. Highlight loyalty, service, dedication, and time involved in nominee's achievements, certainly emphasize previous recognitions. This is a good place to identify the candidate with the precepts of the Covenant of Service. Remember, members who have served at the Club level only, will be scored the same as those who have served at a higher level.

#### **NEWCOMER OF THE YEAR**

**AWARD:** Certificate awarded to Exchange member who participates and leads club

activities during his/her first year. This person surpasses what is expected

and promotes the mission and vision of Exchange.

**ELIGIBILITY:** Any Four Corners' District Exchange member that have been members

one year or less

**JUDGING:** Four Corners' District Awards Committee

**CRITERIA:** Nominee must be a member for one year or less

A one-page description of the activities and accomplishments of nominee will be submitted by the club president. Award will be presented at the

**District Convention** 

#### **MISCELLANEOUS AWARDS**

**AWARD:** This Four Corners' District President will have the option to recognize the
